

**YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR A
CREDIT OF UP TO \$9,000 ON YOUR
2017 MAINE TAX RETURN!**

AccessAble Home is a Maine income tax credit available to individuals who earn \$55,000 or less annually who are making their residence accessible for a person with a physical disability or hardship who lives in the house.

The AccessAble Home Tax Credit is available for qualifying work billed in 2017. Taxpayer must request certification from MaineHousing by March 1, 2018 to take the credit on their 2017 Maine tax return due April 17, 2018.

Examples of Eligible Work:

- Changes to flooring to reduce tripping hazards
- Installing grab bars
- Installing access ramps
- Widening doorways
- Creating an accessible parking space
- Making tubs & showers accessible
